



Musical Director – Tony Matthews

Tony studied music at the University of Worcester and London University Goldsmiths' College before continuing his vocal training with Dennis Wicks at ENO. As an instrumentalist he has played with a wide range of musical ensembles and currently plays saxophone with the Beverley Big Band. Tony has been singing with ROS for many years, taking roles such as Barinkay (Gipsy Baron), Orpheus (Orpheus in the Underworld), the Major General (The Pirates of Penzance) and Ko Ko (The Mikado). This is his tenth production as musical director for shows that have included Me and My Girl, HMS Pinafore, Calamity Jane, Iolanthe, South Pacific, Marguerite and The Addams Family. He has very much enjoyed working with the talented cast of Oklahoma! and wishes them all a very successful show week.



Choreographer – Sarah Matthews

Sarah started dancing at the age of 3. This is Sarah's 13th year with ROS having joined as part of the chorus in Me & My Girl. Her passion is dancing having played a Hot Box Girl in Guys & Dolls and one of Reno's Angels in Anything Goes. As well as being a dancer in the majority of the ROS shows, she has also had small roles such as Suky Tawdry in Beggars Opera, Kate in Pirates of Penzance and Peep Bo in the Mikado. As well as shows with ROS she has also been involved with other local dramatic societies, playing Lyn in Stepping Out for Minster Playhouse, a dancer in Into the Woods and One Singular Sensation and more recently singing in Peter Barnett's Diva show. This is Sarah's third time taking on the role of choreographer for ROS having choreographed HMS Pinafore and Pirates of Penzance before. 


Gary Cordes - Cord Elam

Synopsis

Set in Oklahoma Territory outside the town of Claremore in 1906, this musical tells the story of a pair of lovers. Curly is a cowboy who has trouble admitting his feelings to Laurey, as she does to him, because of their stubbornness. Jud, the hired hand at Laurey's farm, tries to come between them. Woven into this plot is the life of Ado Annie, one of Laurey's friends. Her boyfriend has just gotten back from an exciting trip to Kansas City. While he was away, she has fallen for a peddler who is a ladies' man and doesn't really want to marry her. Does she give Will, her boyfriend, "all or nuthin'", or does she run away with the peddler? Set against the backdrop of ranching Oklahoma, this musical is full of fun, music, and romance for everyone.

Oklahoma! was the first musical written by the team of composer Richard Rodgers and librettist Oscar Hammerstein II. The musical is based on Lynn Riggs' 1931 play, Green Grow the Lilacs.

The original Broadway production opened on March 31, 1943. It was a box-office smash and ran for an unprecedented 2,212 performances, later enjoying award-winning revivals, national tours, foreign productions and an Academy Award-winning 1955 film adaptation. It has long been a popular choice for school and community productions. In 1944 Rodgers & Hammerstein II won a special Pulitzer Prize for Oklahoma!

This musical, building on the innovations of the earlier Show Boat, for which Oscar Hammerstein II wrote the lyrics, epitomized the development of the "book musical", a musical play where the songs and dances are fully integrated into a well-made story with serious dramatic goals that are able to evoke genuine emotions other than laughter. In addition, Oklahoma! features a "dream ballet" that reflects Laurey's struggle with her feelings about two men, Curly and Jud.




