Our shows cost many thousands of pounds to produce, and we are grateful to our headline sponsors, Fosters Law, to our advertisers, and most importantly, to you – our patrons – for the continued support you have shown to us. We couldn't do it without you!

I am also excited about our new youth group, "Rozzers Youth", which began in October, and meets every Saturday morning at Artwise in St. Luke's Avenue, Ramsgate. We look forward to their first outing in "Fairy Tales" at the end of June 2014, and hope that the members will graduate into the main company in the future.

As for the show, I am sure that you will be blown away! "Jekyll and Hyde" was first performed on Broadway in 1997, and made its UK debut with a national tour which began in Eastbourne in August 2004, with Paul Nicholas in the title role. There was a second tour of the UK and Ireland in 2011, when Marti Pellow took on the challenging principal role.

Since the closure of the Broadway production, the rights have been made available to amateur groups, and there have been a number of regional performances. The show has also been translated into a concert version, and a film version is in the planning stages.

### ----The Story-----

### The action takes place in London in the late 19th Century

Jekyll and Hyde is based upon the classic story by Robert Louis Stevenson. Dr Henry Jekyll is shaken by his father's mental illness and invents the chemical HJ7 which he believes can cure debilitating mental illness by separating man's evil nature from his good. Jekyll presents his research proposal to the Board of Governors of St Jude's Hospital, where his father is incarcerated, and explains how he would like to test his theory and his formula on a human subject, presumably his father. The Board are pompous, rich, semi-hypocrites who reject the proposal with cries of "lunacy, heresy, sacrilege, blasphemy".

Jekyll is late for his engagement party to Emma Carew, the daughter of Sir Danvers who is Chairman of the Board of Governors; at the party the guests talk about how worried they are about Emma being engaged to a 'madman'. When Jekyll arrives he and Emma have a moment together and he explains how he may always be busy with his work but she says that she will always be with him.

Jekyll and Utterson, his friend and lawyer, go the 'The Red Rat' in Camden Town for the bachelor party. They watch Lucy Harris, a prostitute perform the number 'Bring on the Men'. Jekyll and Lucy are drawn to one another and he tells her how the song has helped him to find the answer to a problem. Jekyll and Utterson prepare to leave and Jekyll gives Lucy his card, telling her to see him if she should ever need a friend. As they return to Jekyll's house Jekyll tells Utterson that he has found a subject for his experiments. Jekyll dismisses his butler for the night, goes to his laboratory and, making copious notes in his journal, prepares the formula and injects the subject – himself! The potion takes effect, he writhes in pain and then is taken over by an alternate, aggressive personality who calls himself Edward Hyde. Jekyll shuts himself away much to the consternation of Emma, Sir Danvers and Utterson but during this time Hyde goes on a rampage through the streets of London.

Lucy arrives at Jekyll's residence with a nasty wound to her back, as he treats it she tells him that it was done by a man called Hyde; Jekyll is appalled at his own actions. Meanwhile Hyde is out on the streets, taking his revenge.

The citizens of London gossip about the dreadful murders that are taking place, by now all five Governors who rejected Jekylls proposal are dead. Jekyll is distraught because he realises that Hyde has taken a heavy toll on him and those around him and now the transformations are happening of their own accord, he has to face the fact that Hyde is a part of him. His friend Utterson realises what is happening and agrees to help by obtaining some more chemicals, Jekyll mixes a new formula in the hopes that he can restore his former life.

A few weeks later Jekyll seems to have regained control but as he and Emma stand before the Priest at the wedding he doubles over in pain, Hyde has returned – with dramatic consequences.




