

Welcome to the Granville Theatre and to Ramsgate Operatic Society's production of 'Honk!'. We are delighted to announce that for the second year running the Society received the Obelisk Award for 'Best Production 2015' for 'Fiddler On the Roof', as well as members of the Society taking home the 'Best Actress', 'Best Female Vocalist', 'Best Male Vocalist' & 'Best Performer Under 16' awards. In total 'Fiddler On the Roof' was nominated for a staggering 12 awards. A huge honour.

Since it first hatched in 1993 George Stiles & Anthony Drewe's musical Honk! based on Hans Christian Andersen's fairy tale The Ugly Duckling, has winged its way around the world in over 8000 productions and in many different languages. Winner of multiple awards, including the 2000 Olivier Award for Best Musical, this heart-warming celebration of being different is sure to delight audiences of all ages with its sparkling wit and memorable score.

Honk! tells the story of an odd-looking baby duck, Ugly, and his quest to find his mother. Soon after Ugly is born, he is seduced away by a wily Cat who wants to eat Ugly for dinner. Eventually, Ugly manages to escape, but has no idea how to return home. He embarks on an adventure in which he encounters a beautiful swan, Penny, tangled in a fishing line. After saving her, the two birds fall in love. Penny, however, must return to her flock and fly south for the winter. Determined to find his family, Ugly journeys on, only to become frozen in the snow. Eventually, Ugly's mother finds him and her warm tears manage to thaw him out. He revives, and is surprised to discover he is now a handsome swan! Soon, Ugly is reunited with Penny and two swans decide to live the rest of their days in the same pond as Ugly's loyal mother.

Honk! Is notable for the wide range of cast and It is particularly pleasing to see members of the Society's junior section, Rozzers, take to the show like ducks to water! 




#### NATE KARRO - BARNACLES/PRINCIPAL DANCER


#### **EMILY HINKS-CULLEN - COMPANY (Mandarin)**




