THE STORY

Half A Sixpence has all the elements of a great family musical - feel-good songs, a love story and a guaranteed happy ending.

Based on the classic HG Wells novel, it tells the heart-warming story of orphan Arthur Kipps (or Arty) who works as an apprentice draper until he inherits a fortune.
